The Pastor’s Bible Study Group WILL meet Wednesday morning at 10:30am.

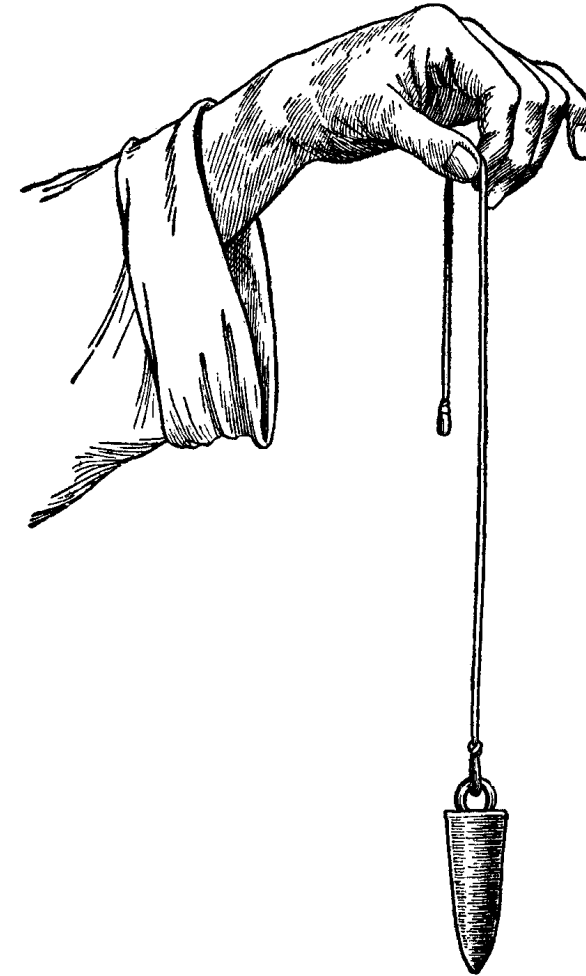
The Sanctuary Choir will hold choir practice on Wednesday evening at 5:30pm.
